1 Important Information

1.1 User Notice

The UAS Toolbox™ (“Software”) is licensed to you (“User”) by Aerial Information Systems Corporation (“AISC”). Installing this toolbox constitutes acknowledgement and agreement to the conditions set forth in this section.

1.2 License

The Software is a collection of functions which are licensed individually can be purchased separately. This license applies to each and every function within the Software.

The license allows you to:

- (a) Use one copy of the Software on a single computer at a time. To “use” the Software means that the Software is either loaded in the temporary memory of a computer or installed on a hard drive or other removable media connected to a computer.
- (b) Make a reasonable number of backup copies on media accessible only by the User’s technical representative.
- (c) Install one copy on a desktop computer and one copy of a laptop computer per user subject to the restrictions of (a).
- (d) Use the software until the license is terminated.
- (e) Use the software for code generation or compilation of stand-alone applications as long as the applications are not for resale or deployment to more than two computers.

1.9 Support

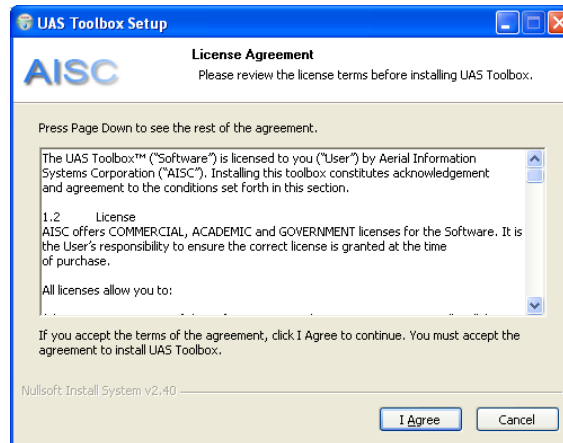

2 Installation

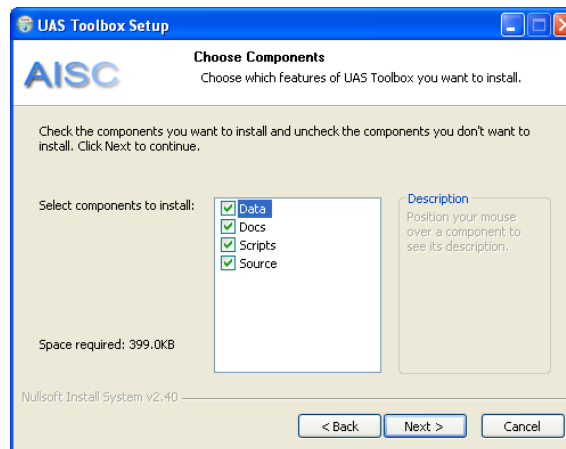
2.1 Windows Installer

A Microsoft Windows® installer/uninstaller is provided for the full UAS Toolbox™.

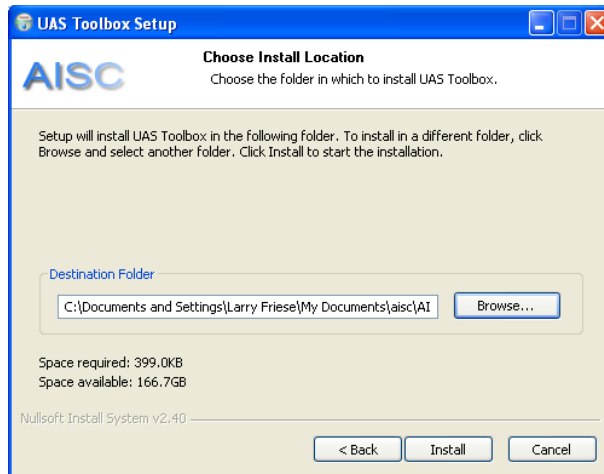
- Execute the installer. Read the License Agreement and Press “I Agree” if you agree to it.



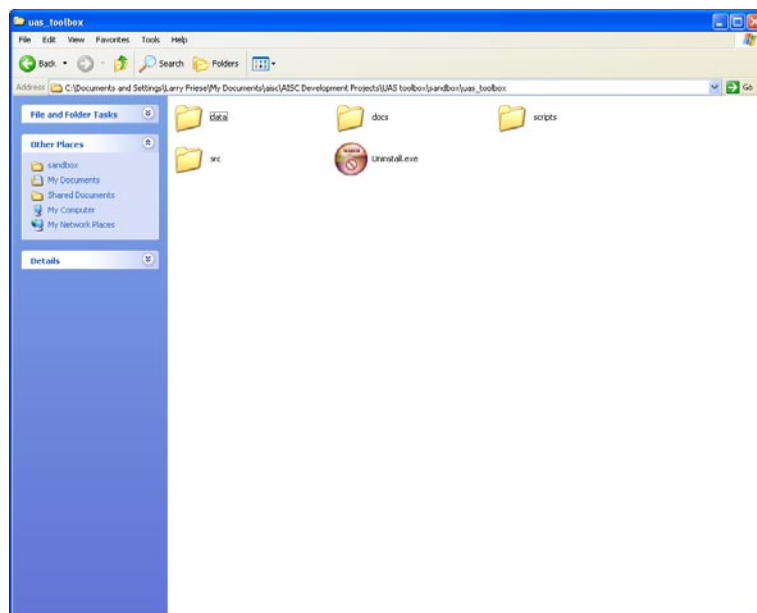
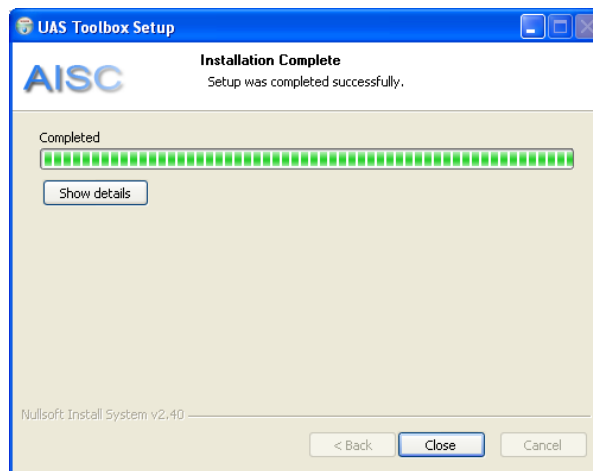
- Select the components you want to install. We recommend you accept the default of a full installation.



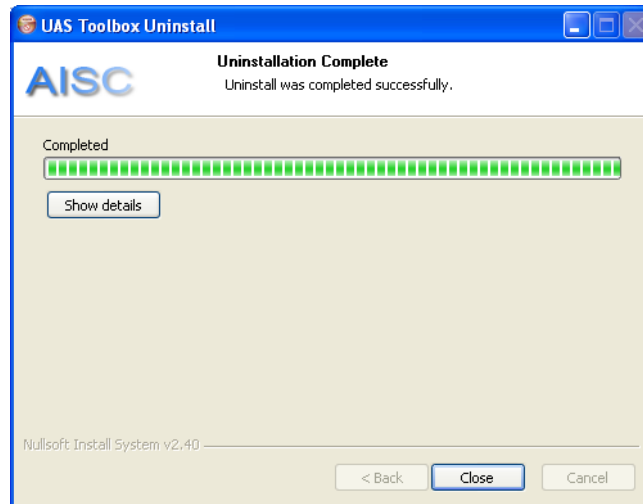
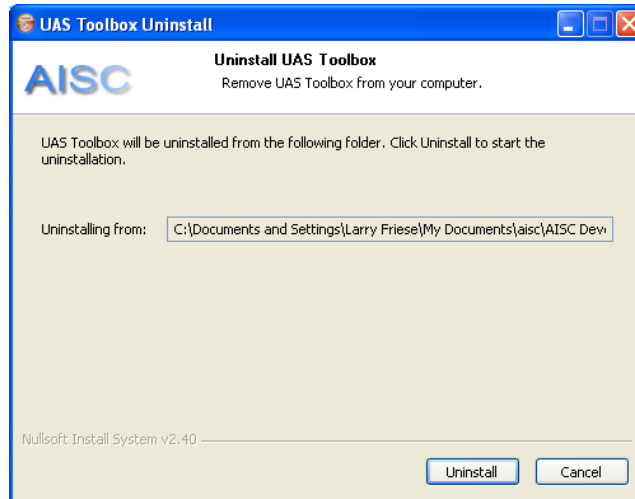
- Select the destination folder and press “Click.”



- Once the installation is complete, Press "Close."



- To uninstall, go to the uast folder and run *uninstall.exe*. Press “Uninstall” to start to process. **IMPORTANT: The entire uast folder will be deleted.** When the process is complete, press “Close.” If you ran the uninstaller from a window, the window may disappear when once the process is complete.



- Go to Section 2.3.

2.2 Manual Installation

Manual installation is currently required for non-Windows operating systems and when installing individual functions and performing updates.

Table 1. Manual Installation

Step	Action
1	Read and acknowledge the license in this document.
2	Create the directory uast
3	Extract the installation zip file into uast . The directory structure will be the same as pictured above.
4	Go to Section 2.3

Table 2. Function By Function Installation (New and Updates)

Step	Action
1	If new install, complete steps 1 and 2 of Table 1, then proceed to Step 3
2	Within the uast directory, create the following directories: src data scripts docs
3	Place m-files in src Place mat files in data Place demo, how-to, etc scripts in scripts Place documentation in docs (<i>optional</i>)
4	Go to Section 2.3

NOTE: To uninstall a manual installation, you just need to delete the files and directories. You should perform this action before using the Windows installer.

2.3 Setup

Once the toolbox is installed, you need to add it to your Matlab® path. Select “Set Path...” and press “Add with Subfolders...” Select the **uast** and press “Save.” Remember to delete these from the Matlab® path if you uninstall the software.
